Venue

Denmark

Situated in southern Scandinavia, the Kingdom of Denmark covers an area of 42,916 square kilometers and with a population of 5.6 million, the population density is 130 per square kilometer. Copenhagen

Situated near Øresund, The Danish capital has a population of 1.2 million inhabitants. Among other things, Copenhagen is famous for Tivoli Gardens, The Little Mermaid, Christiansborg Palace, the Queen's residence Amalienborg and Nyhavn. Copenhagen furthermore encourages green living.

North Sealand, Hillerød and Allerød

North Sealand is named Denmark's Royal Retreat due to the many Royal castles in the region. The beautiful north coast of Sealand is also called the Danish Riviera.

Hillerød is the central city of North Sealand. More than 31,500 inhabitants. The 17th-century Frederiksborg Castle lies on 3 islets and has baroque gardens. Inside the castle, the Museum of National History evokes 500 years of Danish history with portraits and furniture. To the east, Hillerød Town Museum has vintage printing presses and replicas of 19th-century streets. Hillerød is surrounded by forests. North of the city are the trails of Gribskov forest. South of the city St. Dyrehave forest.

Allerød is a suburb where the municipality is combined by a number of smaller urban areas. The main city Lillerød changed in 1952 its name to Allerød to prevent name confusion with Hillerød. **Allerød is located approx. 8 km south of Hillerød.** Allerød has almost 25,000 inhabitants. In Allerød there are plenty of grocery stores, bicycle stores, cinema and theater.

The par force hunting landscape in North Sealand

The forests of North Sealand boast more than just beautiful landscapes; they are also unique cultural sites. Indeed, the forests were landscaped to provide a backdrop for the most magnificent form of hunting: the powerful, absolute monarch's majestic par force hunt.

One world heritage site – three forests

The par force hunting landscape of North Sealand comprises Gribskov Forest, St. Dyrehave and Jægersborg Hegn. These three forests represent a unique cultural landscape that bears witness both to the enormous power wielded by King Christian V and to his need to display it by subjugating nature.

In 2015 the par force hunting landscape was inscribed on the UNESCO world heritage list, because it is a unique and authentic example of the interchange and development of ideas about landscape design in Europe in the 1600s.

The hunting rides, which lie at the heart of the par force hunting landscape, bear witness to these developments and show how the absolutist rulers of the continent demonstrated their power by controlling nature.





We are offering Young Guns and their leaders a special accommodation – hard surface in a school.

Allerød OK and the Danish National Junior and Youth Team are looking forward to welcome you to the MTBO Camp and two Young Guns competitions for Youth and Junior at the MTBO Camp 2018.

The competitions and the trainings are all described on the webpage <http://mtbocamp.dk/mtbo-camp-2018>. There will be separate male and female classes for both Junior and Youth (Youth born in 2001 or later and Junior born between 1998-2000).

But, we will also invite you to a social event including a low-cost accommodation on hard surfaces in classrooms. We will organize common meals, with a little help from you with some of the cooking and the dishwashing.

The school is only a few hundred meters away from the Event Center, see plan above.

The school will be open from Wednesday after the competition. The first common meal will be breakfast Thursday morning and the last will be breakfast Sunday morning.

The total price for accommodation and meals (breakfast, lunch pack and dinner) will be 80€ for each youth and junior rider and national team leader.

Due to a limited space we recommend that you sign up right away (and not later than April 30) by mailing YoungGuns@MTBOCamp.dk telling the names of participants.

Course information

Maps

The maps will be of high standard and updated in the weeks up to camp, so even minor changes in the forests will be included on the maps.

Bib

You will find your bib number in your participant bag, which is handed out at check in at the Event Office, Wednesday 9 May 15:00 – 21:30. Strips are also provided. The bib is to be mounted on the front of your bike and it is used for the whole camp. If you lose your bib please ask for a new one at the Event Office.

Competitions rules

All races will be organized in accordance with the Competitions Rules for IOF MTB Orienteering Events as published by the IOF and valid from January 1, 2018, and the IOF Anti-Doping Rules valid from February 1, 2010.

Riding off track is not allowed

Participants are not allowed riding off track and road. Exceptions are 100% yellow areas (only few places and not relevant for the courses) and areas marked as paved/parking.

Controls placed off track

No off track controls

Doping

Doping is strictly forbidden. There might be a visit from the anti-doping authorities.

Transport offered

None. Most events are within reasonable bike distance (if you are fit) from the Event Center.

Punching system – SportIdent – TOUCH FREE (distance 20-30 cm)

For Camp Cup 1, 2, 3 and 4 SI-cards 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11 and SIAC1 can be used.

For the "Høker" ultra long only SI-cards 6, 9, 10, 11 and SIAC1 can be used in class WE and ME because of more than 30 controls.

SI-cards 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 or 11 can be used in all other classes.

If you want the full advantage of the TOUCH FREE system you need an SIAC1 card.

If you want, you can rent a valid SIAC1 card at the Event Office. Fee for the whole MTBO camp is € 15 / DKK 100 (5 competitions)

If you want to buy a Sportident SIAC1 card (price € 80 / DKK 600) then drop a mail to info@mtbocamp.dk no later than 1 May with your order

Start

The one competition with free start is Camp Cup 1, the Wednesday evening race. Minimum start interval within each class is 1 minute, and we therefore encourage especially ML riders to show up early to make sure that everyone gets started in due time.

Terrain

Most of the terrain will be relatively open forest with a lot of roads and tracks. The terrains are relative flat. Though, from a Danish perspective, the terrains to be used Friday, Rude Skov and Geels Skov, are relatively hilly.

Competition clothing

Not required, but recommended indeed. Helmet is mandatory 😊

Prize giving

There will be prize giving ceremonies at the Event Center:

- Thursday at the FUN Race and
- Saturday at 19:00, (Camp Cup overall)

There will be prizes for the best riders in each class (in Cool Kids only for the best riders born 2005 or later)

1st place 35 points
 2nd place 33 points
 3rd place 31 points
 4th place 30 points
 5th place 29 points
 etc....

There will be no results for the Men/Women Long and Men/Women Short classes.

As MTBO Camp is also a training event, it is possible for all participants to ride other courses than the class based on their age and class they have signed up for in the WMS races.

If you choose to participate in other classes for these courses, you cannot participate in the overall Camp Cup as they will be calculated based on participation in the same class all week.
