

Sankt Helene Holiday Center is easily accessible by car and public transport.

Within a short distance you will find restaurants and some shops. In the event center you will find free Wi-Fi, bike wash facilities, bike storage etc.

You will also within a short distance find the "Danish Riviera" with miles of sandy beaches. The weather in Tisvilde in early April is mostly dry; April is the month with least rain. Average temperatures are 10 degrees in daytime, 3 during night, and an average of 6-8 hours of sunshine daily. However weather may shift with short notice, and days with subzero temperatures and snow has occurred, although rare.



5. Rules / Doping

The MTBO CAMP 2022 will be organized in accordance with the Competition Rules for IOF MTB Orienteering Events, valid from 1 of January 2019.

• Riding off the tracks is generally forbidden.



- Riding off tracks in areas with symbol 839, open land (orange) or 839-3 forested area (black dots) is permitted.
- MTB tracks may be mapped with grey/black. If MTB tracks are unidirectional, riding direction is marked with purple arrow. One way direction must be respected.
- Violation of the rules may, if done deliberately, results in exclusion from the camp without compensation.
- Doping is strictly prohibited.

The organizers will not be liable for any health insurance for participants. It is recommended that all participants arrange their own personal health insurance. Participation is at own risk. Sales of any kind are not allowed at the competitions or at the Event Center unless you have made an agreement with the organizers.

8. Competition information

For participation in MTBO-Camp 2022 there are the following options:Short Camp: Only race 1 + 3, no trainingsFull Camp: All 6 races and trainings.

Races Saturday, 9 of April (long distance Tisvilde) and Sunday 10 of April (middle distance Horserød Hegn etc.) will be WRE races, as well as part of Young Guns and Masters Series. We will try to adapt the length of Camp race 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 in accordance with the IOF recommendations (https://orienteering.sport/mtbo/competition-rules/).

For the ultra-long (UL) distance there will be 5 courses (guiding course lengths):

If you wish to do the ultralong in a different class than your age group/ or registered age class, please indicate it on the registration (see entry p.14).

There will be separate results for all Camp races. However, there are no official results or prizes for the overall camp competition.

There will be sponsor gifts and lottery prizes. The lottery will take place at Monday the 11^{th} of April at 8.00 – 8.30 p.m. (after the banquet). Participants not taking part in the banquet are welcome at this time.

9. Maps

The maps are produced in accordance with the International Standard for Mountain Bike Orienteering Maps ISMTBOM 2010 and later amendments.






<u>Camp Race 1: 9/4 2022, WRE;</u> World Masters and Young Guns Series. Long distance, 9/4 2022 Map: Tisvilde Hegn, revised 2022

Map scale 1: 10.000 & 1: 15.000 contour: 2, 5 m:


Terrain is moderately hilly with mixed forest and a network of paths and tracks. The surface is sandy, making some tracks heavy to ride, but tracks are mostly dry and fast. There is an MTB track marked with grey/black. Parts of the track may be marked as unidirectional on the map using violet arrows. This must be respected.



Camp race 2: 9/4 2022: Crying Mile, Tisvilde Hegn North.

Map: Tisvilde Hegn North revised 2022. 1: 5.000, contour 2,5 m

Hilly area with an abundance of small to medium sized tracks and paths, some are unidirectional.





<u>Camp race 3: 10/4 2022.</u> WRE, World Masters and Young Guns Series. Middle distance 10/4 2020 Map: Klosterris Hegn

Map scale: 1: 10.000, revised 2021, contour 2, 5 m

Typical Danish Forest, with mixed vegetation, moderately hilly with a dense network of paths and gravel roads.



Camp Race 4: 10/4 2020. Sprint Map: Frederiksværk, revised 2022 Map scale 1: 5.000 & 1: 7.500 contour: 2, 5 m:

Terrain is partly hilly urban forest with a dense network of paths and tracks in a deciduous forest; part of the race crosses a residential neighborhood with public roads. In rainy periods some paths may be slippery.






Camp Race 5: 11/4 2022: Ultra long distance.

Map: Grib Skov. Revised 2021&22.

Map scale: 1: 10.000 & 1: 15.000, contour 2,5 m

Typical Danish Forest, with mixed vegetation, moderately hilly. Abundance of gravel roads, and some small and medium sized tracks. Due to the use of heavy machines in the forest, minor tracks may have changed character or be difficult to see. In opposition to previous ultra long distance races there is almost no asphalt.



Camp Race 6: 12/4 2022. Middle distance, Grib Skov North,

Map: Grib Skov North, revised 2021

Map scale: 1: 10.000 contour 2,5 m.

Slightly hilly Danish forest with a mixture of deciduous and coniferous trees, a sparse network of gravel roads and moderate to minor tracks and paths, mostly well ridden. The forest is also used of riding schools, so be careful and give a signal well in advance.



<u>Training: 12/4 2022</u>, Grib Skov Søskoven Map: Søskoven, 1: 10.000, contour 2,5 m Mixed forest, pretty hilly, lot of gravel and old asphalt.



10. Time keeping system

SPORT*ident touch free short range* will be used in all competitions.

All competitors will have to use an ActiveCard (SIAC/SIair). Old school SI Cards is also usable, but you will be slower in the forest. SIAC rental (touch free) will be possible. Order and pay upon registration.

11. Entries and entry fees

Entries will be opened in early December 2021. Ordinary registration period expires at the 31st of January; extended registration period ends 28th of February 2022. Number of participants is limited to 300.

For participation in MTBO-Camp 2022 there are the following options:

Short Camp: Only race 1 + 3, no trainings

Full Camp: All 6 races and trainings.

For both options you may register in alternative age classes, according to IOF rules. Participants in Full Camp, you may choose other classes for the ultralong (Camp Race 5). Decision concerning the age class and length of the ultralong race must be made at registration, and cannot be changed after 28/2 2022.

Participants from Denmark: Use "O-service" and specify kind of camp (Full Camp/Short Camp) If you wish to rent a SI air, erase your own SI no., and the price will be adjusted accordingly. If you don't have a SI no. you will automatically be assigned to one. Danish participants wishing to participate in the banquet should check this box on O-Service.

Entry fees and deadlines:

For M/W 12 participating in camps is for free.

Full payment must be made in connection to the entries.

Entries are only valid if payment has been made, no later than applicable deadline.

Danish participants: Entry fee automatic via O-Service, including banquet if chosen.

Participants pay the fee to own bank. Organizers pay the fee to organizer's bank (included in entry fee).

If you have paid, and don't show up on the list of participants, please take contact ASAP (mail).

If you have to pay something in cash in Denmark, be aware that Euro banknotes larger than 50 € cannot be received or exchanged.



Withdrawals

Withdrawals will be accepted as follow:

- Until 31th of January 2022: withdrawals receive a 50 % refund.
- After 31th of January 2022, withdrawals will not be accepted.

12. Accommodation

Accommodation is not included in the camp entry fee. However, the organizers have made an agreement with Sankt Helene Holiday Center – same location as the Event Center. We have prebooked all apartments until **1 of February**. That is, if you don't make your booking before this date you might have find accommodation somewhere else.

Socializing

We encourage socializing with your MTBO-friends and discussing the daily races in a shared living room with fireplace open until 11 p.m. every day. A minor café with sales of coffee, beers, water etc. will be open.

13. Transportation

The organizers do not offer transportation during the Camp. Competitors/participants must arrange own transportation.

Train from CPH airport: Metro (M2) direction Vanløse, change at Nørreport to: S-train line A, from Nørreport to Hillerød. Change to train 960R direction Tisvildeleje, leave train at Godhavn Station, and walk 400 m.

Train from Copenhagen central station: S-train line A in direction Hillerød. In Hillerød: as mentioned above.

14. Entry permits (Visas)

Denmark is a full Schengen member state. Non-Schengen residents may have to apply for a short stay visa. Read more here:

15. Covid 19

Currently there are no restrictions for Danes or foreigners with accepted entry into Denmark in terms of assembly size and use of masks. However you are responsible for complying with the rules for entry Into Denmark (<u>https://en.coronasmitte.dk/ulers-and-regulations/entry-into-</u><u>denmark/categorization-of-countries</u>), and reentry to your home country. As the situation can change quickly, we strongly recommend that you can present proof of full vaccination or previously



C-19 illness, possibly an EU corona pass (<u>All Details on EU COVID-19 Vaccine Passport Revealed: Here's</u> What You Need to Know - <u>SchengenVisaInfo.com</u>).

Rejection at the border for any reason does not in itself entail a refund, or reimbursement of travel expenses. However, in case of restrictions imposed after registration, and preventing participation, the entire entry fee will be refunded.
